A person selected for appointment to the post shall be required to get himself registered under the Dentist Act, 1948 (16 of 1948), before joining the post unless he has already so registered or his name is borne on the register maintained under the Dentists Act, 1948 (16 of 1948) by the Dental Council of India.

9. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. RTR-1087/783/CR-26/87/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Cyto-Geneticist, General State Service, Class II, in the Government Medical Colleges under the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State, under the Medical Education and Drugs Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Cyto-Geneticist (Recruitment) Rules, 1989.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise, "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Cyto-Geneticist, General State Service, Class II, in the Government Medical College under the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State, shall be made by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than 35 years of age;

(ii) possess M.Sc. degree of a statutory University in Microbiology or Biochemistry;

(iii) possess, after acquiring qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii), not less than three year's experience in Genetics in a Paediatric Laboratory.

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed by the Government, on the recommendation of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission, in favour of candidate possessing exceptional qualifications or experience of research, in the relevant subject, or both.

(iii) possess experience gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) above as Clinical Assistant, or Houseman in Dentistry or in equivalent or higher post in Dental or Medical Colleges for not less than one year:

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualifications or experience, or both:

Provided further that, preference may be given to candidates who possess,—

- (i) a post graduate qualification in Dental subject; or
- (ii) any original published work to their credit.

3. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

4. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass the examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he already passed or has been exempted from passing, those examinations.

5. A person appointed to the post shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India or a post connected with the Defence of India, anywhere in or outside India for a period of not less than four years (inclusive of the period spent in training, if any) on such condition as may be determined from time to time by the Government of India:

Provided that, such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment and ordinarily after he has attained the age of forty-five years.

6. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

7. A person selected for appointment to the post shall be required to get himself registered under the Dentists Act, 1948 before joining the post, unless he has already so registered or his name is borne on the register maintained by the Dental Council of India.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. RTR. 1184/907/CR-113-A/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of Government Notification, Urban Development and Public Health Department, No. RTR. 1373/8366-PH-10, dated the 25th April 1977 insofar as it relates to the recruitment rules for the post of Dental Surgeon, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Dental Surgeon, Maharashtra Medical Education and Research Services, Class-II, in the Government Dental Colleges, Government Medical Colleges and at Health Units attached to such colleges under the Directorate of Medical Education and Research of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Dental Surgeon (Maharashtra Medical Education and Research Services, Class-II) in Government Dental Colleges, Medical Colleges and Health Units attached to such colleges under the Directorate of Medical Education and Research (Recruitment) Rules, 1987.

2. Appointment to the post of Dental Surgeon, in the Government Dental Colleges, Medical Colleges and at Health Unit attached to such colleges under the Directorate of Medical Education and Research of the Government of Maharashtra, shall be made by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government of Maharashtra are not less than 32 years of age ;

(ii) possess B.D.S. degree of a statutory university or other equivalent qualification recognised by the Dental Council of India ; and
