

5. A person selected for appointment to the post shall be required to register himself under the Bombay Homoeopathic and Bioclinical Practitioners' Act, 1959, before joining the service, unless he is already so registered.

6. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion or by nomination shall be required to pass examinations in Marathi and Hindi according to the rules made in that behalf unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing such examinations.

#### CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. RTR. 1283/228/CR-120/84/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the posts of Lecturers in Dental subjects in the Government Dental Colleges and Lecturers in Dentistry in the Government Medical Colleges in Maharashtra Medical Education and Research Services, Class II, under the Directorate of Medical Education and Research of the Medical Education and Drugs Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the "Lecturers in Dental subjects and Dentistry in the Maharashtra Medical Education and Research Services, Class II, in the Directorate of Medical Education and Research (Recruitment) Rules, 1986.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

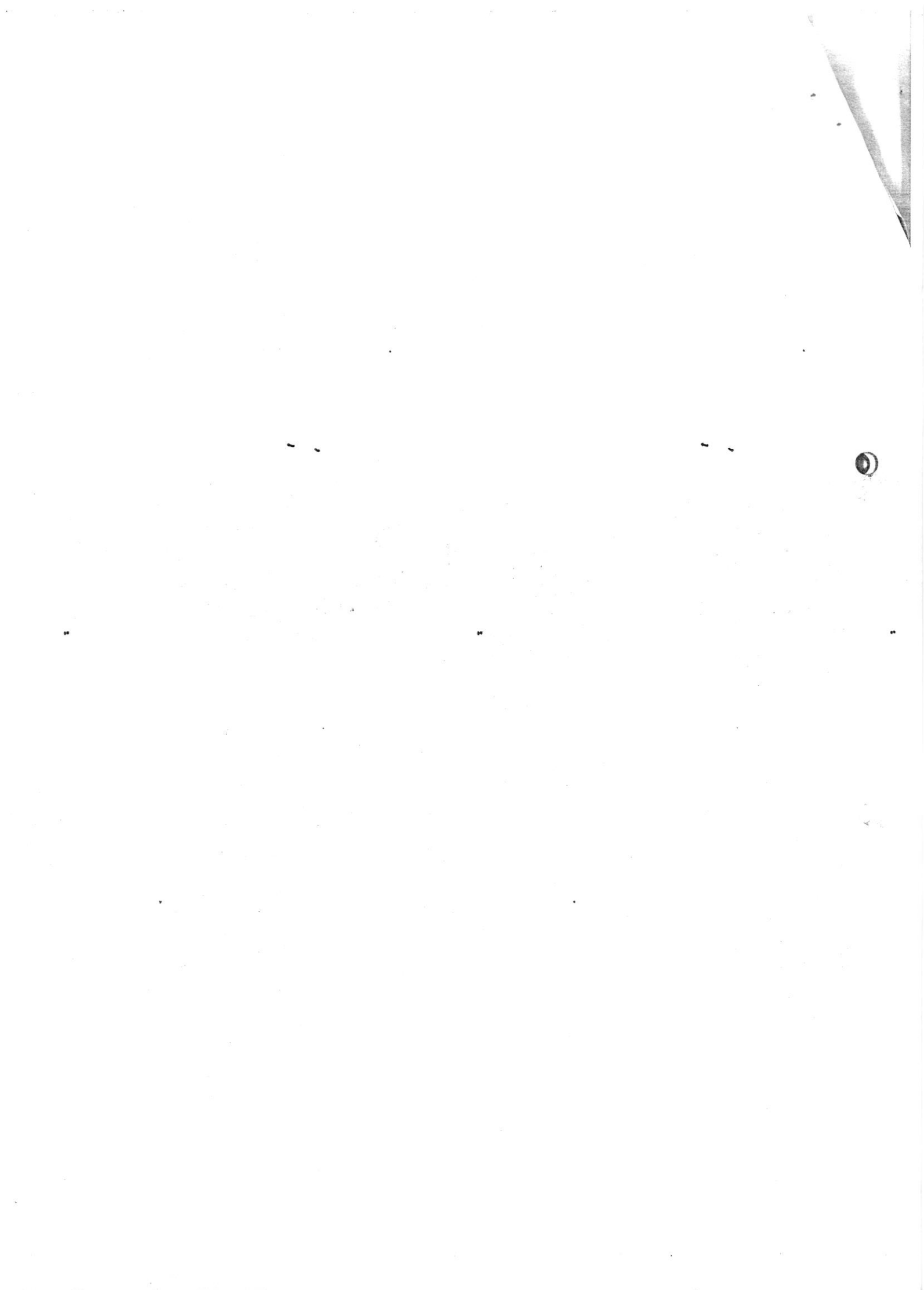
- (a) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;
- (b) "Recognised post-graduate qualification" means post-graduate qualification recognised under the Dentist Act, 1948;
- (c) "Schedule" means the Schedule appended to these rules.

3. Appointment to the post of Lecturer in any Dental subject or Dentistry shall be made by nomination from amongst candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 32 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree of Bachelor of Dental Surgery of a recognised university or its equivalent qualification and a recognised post-graduate qualification of a statutory university in the relevant subject; and

(iii) possess experience for at least one year as a Clinical Assistant, Houseman (Dental) or Dental Surgeon or in any higher post in a Government or Semi-Government Dental Hospital or in a Hospital attached to a medical college, gained after acquired the degree of Bachelor of Dental Surgery :

Provided that, where candidates possessing post-graduate qualification in the Dental and Oral Anatomy, Dental Materials, Community Dentistry, Dental Mechanics and Dental Hygienist are not available, the candidates possessing recognised post-graduate qualification in the subject mentioned in column (2) against the post mentioned in column (1) in the Schedule, may be considered eligible for appointment to the relevant post of Lecturer mentioned in column (1) of the Schedule :

Provided further that, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission in favour of candidates having exceptional qualification or experience or both.

4. A person appointed to the post shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing those examinations.

6. A person appointed to the post shall, if so required be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India or a post connected with the Defence of India, anywhere in or outside India for a period of not less than four years, inclusive of the period spent in training, if any, on such conditions as may be determined from time to time by the Government of India :

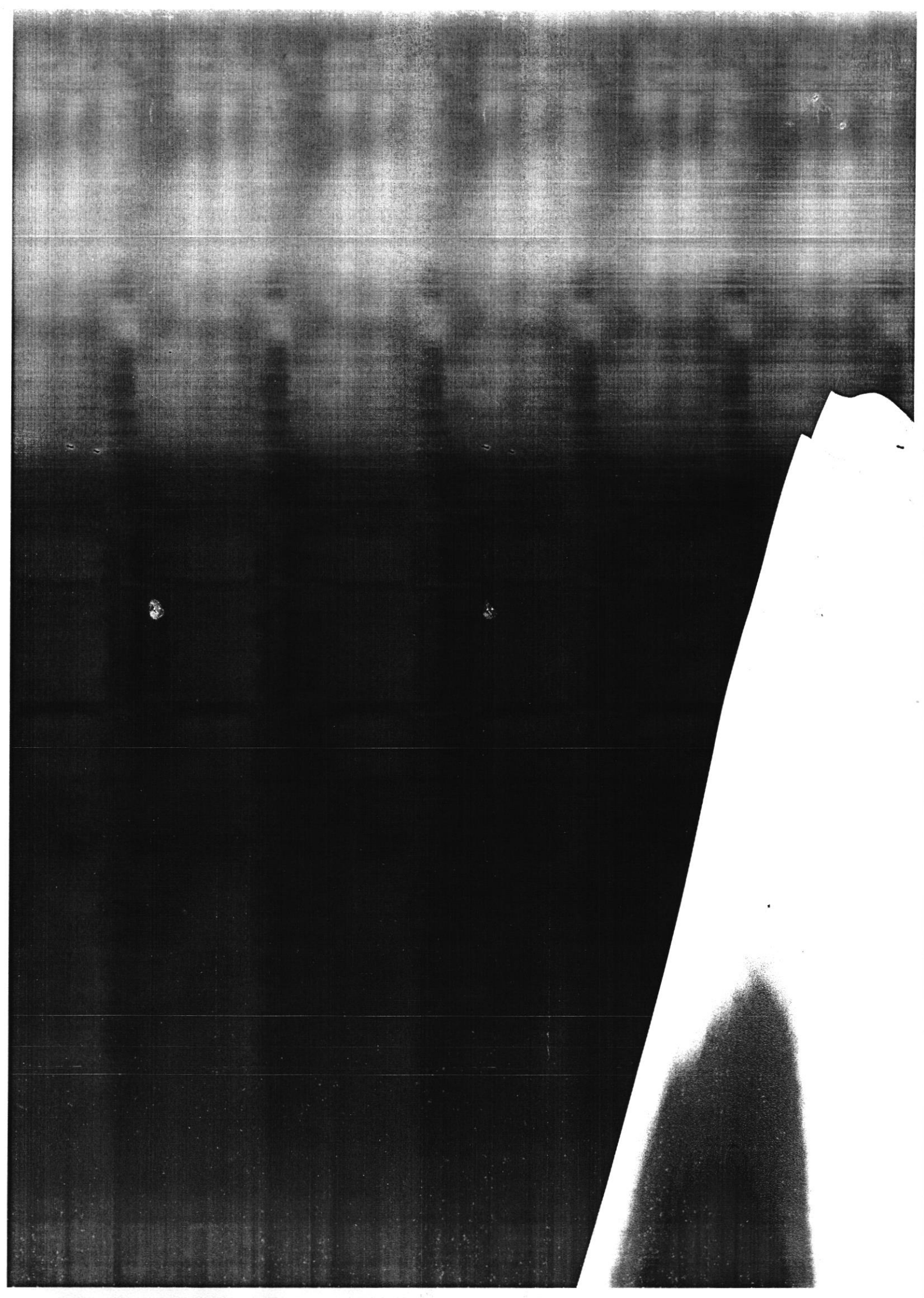
Provided that such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment or after attaining the age of forty, forty-five years.

7. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

8. A person selected for appointment to the post shall be required to get himself registered under the Dentist Act, 1948, before joining the post unless he has already so registered or his name is borne on the Dental Council of India register maintained under the said Act.

No. RTR. 1084/214/CR-85/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, and in force in this State or in any part thereof, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Administrative Officer, General State Service, Class-II, in the Directorate of Medical Education and Research under the Medical Education and Drugs Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Administrative Officer in the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, General State Service, Class-II (Recruitment) Rules, 1985.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

- (a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;
- (b) "Degree" means a degree of a Statutory University;
- (c) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Medical Education and Research under the Medical Education and Drugs Department of Government;
- (d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Administrative Officer in the Directorate shall be made either—

- (a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons holding for a period of not less than three years, the post of Superintendent, Steward, Account or Accounts Superintendent or any other Class III post under the Directorate declared by Government as equivalent to these post; or
