CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. RTR. 1283/439/CR-135/MED-14.--In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or Instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the posts of Joint Director of Medical Education and Research (Dental), Dean and Professor in a Government Dental College and Hospital and Professor in Dentistry in a Government Medical College and Hospital in Maharashtra Medical Education and Research Service, Class-I, in the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, under the Medical Education and Drugs Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Joint Director of Medical Education and Research (Dental), Dean and Professor in Government Dental College and Hospital, and Professor in Dentistry in a Government Medical College and Hospital (Recruitment) Rules, 1988.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) "Act" means the Dentists Act, 1948 (16 of 1948);

(b) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;

(c) "Degree" means a degree of a Statutory University;

(d) "Dental Council of India" means the Dental Council of India constituted under section 3 of the Act;

(e) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Medical Education and Research, Maharashtra State;

(f) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

(g) "Service" means the Maharashtra Medical Education and Research Service, Class-I, in the Directorate; and

(h) "Schedule" means the Schedule appended to these rules.

3. Appointment to the post of Joint Director (Dental) in the service, shall be made either.—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of selection from amongst the persons holding the post of Dean in a Government Dental College and Hospital in the service, possessing qualifications and experience mentioned in columns (3) and (4) respectively against entry 1 of the Schedule; or

(b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than 50 years of age, and

(ii) possess qualifications and experience mentioned in columns (3) and (4) respectively, against entry 1 of the Schedule.

4. Appointment to the post of Dean in a Government Dental College and Hospital, in the Service, shall be made either,—

(i) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of selection from amongst the persons holding the post of Professor in a Government Dental College or a post of Professor in Dentistry in a Government Medical College and Hospital, in the service, possessing qualifications and experience mentioned in columns (3) and (4) respectively, against entry 2 of the Schedule: or

(b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of the Government, are not more than 50 years of age; and

(ii) possess qualifications and experience mentioned in columns (3) and (4) respectively against entry 2 of the Schedule.

5. Appointment to the post of Professor in a Government Dental College and Hospital or to the post of Professor in Dentistry in a Government Medical College and Hospital in the Service, shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of selection from amongst the persons holding the post of Reader in Government Dental Colleges or the post of Reader in Dentistry in a Government Medical College in the Service, possessing qualifications and experience mentioned in columns (3) and (4) against entry 3 of the Schedule; or

(b) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 40 years of age; and

(ii) possess qualifications and experience mentioned in columns (3) and (4) against entry 3 of the Schedule.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in rules 3, 4, and 5 the age limit prescribed in these rules may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of a candidate having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

7. A person appointed by nomination to any of the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 shall be on probation for a period of two years.

8. Appointment to the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50:50.

Provided that, if in the opinion of Government, exigencies of service so require, Government may in consultation with the Commission, relax the ratio prescribed under this rule.

9. A person selected for appointment to any of the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 shall be required to get himself registered under the Act, before joining the post, unless he has already so registered or his name is borne on the Register maintained by Dental Council of India under the Act

10. A person appointed to any of the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India; or a post connected with the defence of India, any where in or outside India for a period of not less than four years (including the period spent on training, if any) on such conditions as may be determined, from time to time, by the Government of India :

Provided that such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of appointment or ordinarily on attaining the age of 45 years.

11. A person appointed to any of the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 whether by promotion or by nomination, shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi in accordance with the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing those examinations.

12. A person appointed to any of the posts mentioned in rules 3, 4 and 5 shall be liable to be transferred anywhere in the State of Maharashtra.

Amendment - Dean & Professor

No. RTR. 1089/24/CR-1/89/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules to amend the Joint Director of Medical Education and Research (Dental), Dean and Professor in Government Dental College and Hospital, and Professor in Dentistry in a Government Medical College and Hospital (Recruitment) Rules 1988, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Joint Director of Medical Education and Research (Dental), Dean and Professor in Government Dental College and Hospital and Professor in Dentistry in Government Medical College and Hospital (Recruitment) (Amendment) Rules, 1989.

2. In the Schedule to the Joint Director of Medical Education and Research (Dental), Dean and Professor in Government Dental College and Hospital and Professor in Dentistry in a Government Medical College and Hospital (Recruitment) rules, 1988—

(a) against entry 1, in column (4), after the words "academic department of a Dental College or" the words "Professor and Head of a Dental department of a Medical College or" shall be inserted:

(b) against entry 2, in column (4), after the words "Dental College" the words "or a Medical College" shall be inserted;

(c) against entry 3, in sub entry (i).—

"(1) Professor of Dental Pathology and Bacteriology";

(ii) in column (4), after the words "in Dental College" the words "or as Assistant Professor or Reader or Senior Lecturer in a Dental Department of a Medical College, acquired after obtaining the qualifications mentioned in column (3)" shall be added;

(d) in Explanation 3,—

(i) for the words, "University or a Dental College", the words "University or a Dental or a Medical College" shall be substituted;

No. FDS. 2087/1496/152/MED-6.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the Senior Scientific Officer in the Drug Control Laboratory, (Preparation, Maintenance and Revision of Select List) Rules, 1978 and any other existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf and in force in the State or in any part thereof, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules for preparation, maintenance and revision of Select List of the persons, holding the post of senior Scientific Officer, in General State Service, Class-I, in the Drugs Central Laboratory, for the purpose of promotion to the post of Assistant Director, in General State Service, Class-I, in the Drugs Control Laboratory, Bombay, namely:—

1. *Short title.*—These rules may be called the Select List for promotion to the post of Assistant Director, Class-I, in the Drugs Control Laboratory, (Preparation, Maintenance and Revision) Rules, 1989.

2. *Definitions.*—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—

(a) "Assistant Director" means an Assistant Director in the General State Services, Class-I, in the Drugs Control Laboratory, Bombay, under the Food and Drugs Administration of the Government;
