CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. GDC-1283/271/CR-146/85/MED-14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of Reader in any Dental subject at Government Dental Colleges and in Dentistry at Government Medical Colleges in Maharashtra Medical Education and Research Service, Class I, under the Directorate of Medical Education and Research of the Medical Education and Drugs Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Reader in Dental subject at Government Dental Colleges and in Dentistry at Government Medical Colleges; in the Maharashtra Medical Education and Research Service, Class I (Recruitment) Rules, 1989.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise :—

(a) "Commission" means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission;

(b) "Degree" means a degree of a statutory University;

(c) "Dental College" means a Dental College run or recognised by the Government;

(d) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;

(e) "Lecturer" means a Lecturer in Dental College or Medical College;

(f) "Medical College" means the Medical College recognised by Government.

3. Appointment to the post of Reader in Government Dental Colleges or in Dentistry at Government Medical Colleges shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the persons from the common cadre of Lecturers holding the posts of Lecturer in relevant subject who possess Masters' Degree in Dental Surgery in the relevant subject and have not less than three years continuous service as Lecturer in that subject;

Provided that, persons who possess Masters' Degree in Dental Surgery in any Dental subject and have put in not less than three years service as Lecturer in Dentistry at Medical College or Lecturer in a Dental subject at Dental College shall be eligible for promotion as Reader in Dentistry; or

(b) by transfer of a suitable Reader in Government Dental College or Reader in Dentistry at Government Medical College possessing Masters' Degree in Dental Surgery in the relevant subject; or

(c) by nomination from amongst candidates who,

(i) unless already in the service of Government, are not more than thirty five years of age;

(ii) possess Masters' Degree in Dental Surgery or an equivalent post-graduate qualification in the relevant subject and in the case of Reader in Dentistry at Medical College, a Masters' Degree in Dental Surgery or in the opinion of the Commission, an equivalent post-graduate qualification in any Dental subject; and

(iii) have experience of teaching the relevant subject as Lecturer in Dental College for not less than three years in the case of Reader in Dental subject and as Lecturer in Dentistry at Medical College or Lecturer in any subject at Dental College for not less than three years in the case of Reader in Dentistry; gained after acquiring qualifications mentioned in sub-clause (ii) :

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission, in favour of candidates possessing exceptional qualification or experience or both.

4. Appointments by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio 50 : 50 :

Provided that, if in the opinion of Government, exigencies of service so require, Government may, in consultation with the Commission, wherever necessary, make appointments to the posts of Reader, in relaxation of the percentage prescribed for recruitment by promotion or nomination :

Provided further that, any appointments made so far in relaxation of the percentage prescribed for recruitment by promotion and nomination under any of the rules, orders or instruments made by Government before commencement of these rules shall be deemed to have been validly made.

5. A person appointed to the post of Reader in Dental College or in Dentistry at Medical College, by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. A person appointed to the post, whether by promotion, nomination or by transfer shall be required to pass examination in Hindi and Marathi according to rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing these examinations.

7. A person appointed to the post shall, if so required be liable to serve in any Defence Service of India, or a post connected with the Defence of India, anywhere in or outside India, for a period of not less than four years (inclusive of the period spent on training, if any) on such conditions as may be determined, from time to time, by the Government of India :

Provided that, such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment and ordinarily after he has attained the age of forty five years.
